The Company reserves the right to modify, re-evaluate, suspend or terminate a contractor's pre-qualification status for but not limited to any one or more of the following reasons:

- a) Available new information indicating material change in contractor's situation from that which existed at the time of pre-qualification approval.
- b) The Company's experiencing ongoing disputes with the contractor on an existing project.
- c) Ongoing problems between the contractor and his creditors necessitating incurrence of Company time and expense.
- d) Failure to provide updated pre-qualification information as requested.

You are further advised that the Company shall review bi-annually this prequalification rating which shall be adjusted to the contractor's current position as determined by the Company.
